I'll be the first to admit I often get it wrong. My eyes easily drift to what doesn't feel settled or clear, and my hands will grasp for anything that feels solid and controllable. But God is always there to correct me with love and kindness. So it is with you, friend.

God doesn't condemn you, but He'll gently take your hand and direct your attention to His promises. He is good, He is steadfast, He is with us, and He is for us. We don't need to see the path or walk it perfectly. We just need to continue returning to truth that never fades or changes. He is that truth.
